Feedback to parents from survey- Autumn 2021

Thank you to all parents who responded to our survey this term. We had 67 responses and we considered them carefully. We have already made contact with parents who requested it. The survey is now closed, however if you need to talk to us please arrange a call via the school office.

Headline results

The following percentages represent the number of parents who agreed or strongly agreed with the questions we posed (answers with less than 6 responses have not been reported so that individuals cannot be identified).


• 97% of parents told us that they agree or strongly agree their child is

happy at Aveley Primary School.



- 99% agreed that their child feels safe.
- 86% said that the school deal with incidents of disruptive behaviour and work with families to sort issues.


Many parents have not had the experience of the school dealing with bullying. 87% of those that did agreed or strongly agreed that we dealt with bullying effectively.



88% of parents are aware of what their children will learn this year. For more information, please see the website https://www.aveleyprimary.org.uk/curriculum/
Of the small number of parents who had needed to raise a concern with the school, 74% said their concern was dealt with properly. We would always encourage parents who still have concerns to talk to us again until the situation is satisfactorily resolved.

93% agree there are high expectations and 95% said that their child does well at APS.

- 92% agree we let parents know how well their child is doing.
- 93% agree that we have a good range of subjects on offer. We know that some events etc. have been hampered by Covid-19 but are hopeful that our offer will go from strength to strength.
- 89% say that we support their child's wider development.
- 89% of parents agree the TLC was useful.
- 89% of parents would recommend our school to another parent. We are also really proud of our school!
