Year 5 – Trip to The Science Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to share that we have arranged for all Year 5 pupils (currently at the end of Year 4) to attend an educational visit on Thursday 3rd October 2024 to **The Science Museum**. This will be part of our topic of **Earth and Space**, and we will also learn more about the following chemistry and biology units of work. During the visit, we will visit the IMAX screen to experience what life would be like for an astronaut aboard the International Space Station with stunning footage of the Earth below. We will also have access to the Exploring Space exhibition. Both experiences will be an excellent consolidation of your child's science learning. While not participating in these activities, we will also enjoy self-led tours of other areas of the Science Museum.

The cost of the trip will be **£18.42** per child, which includes the cost of the transport and access to the experiences described above. This must be paid via Arbor which will accept payments from the start of the new term. If the school is unable to cover the cost of the trip due to a shortfall in payments, the school will cancel the visit and refund parents. **All money must be paid by Friday 13th September 2024**. If you are finding it difficult to make this payment, then please do speak with us to see what other payment arrangements can be made.

What the children will need:

- full school uniform to be worn
- a coat – or light jacket depending on the weather
- packed lunch including a water bottle (no sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks) in a backpack/bag that your child will be prepared to carry. Alternatively, you may wish to order a free school packed lunch if your child is entitled. Please indicate on the return slip.
- **Please ensure your child is in school by 8:15am for registration, as we plan to leave school at 8:30am. We will return to school at approximately 5:00pm.** If we are delayed due to traffic the school office will be informed who will, in turn, notify parents. Even if your child normally walks home alone, someone must be there to collect them.
